Subject: Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and the Council on the law

applicable to non-contractual obligations ("ROME II") <sup>1</sup>

## Article 1(2), new paragraph d bis

"Non-contractual obligations arising out of transactions, such as issuing, admission to trading, offering or marketing, relating to financial instruments, including transferable securities, moneymarket instruments, units in collective investment undertakings, options, futures and other derivatives instruments"

This note was circulated as a meeting document at the meeting of the Committee on Civil Law Matters (Rome II) on 27 and 28 March 2006.

Article 5, new paragraphs 3 and 4

"3 In cases where a restriction of competition affects or is likely to affect trade between Member States within the meaning of Articles 81 or 82 of the EC Treaty, the law applicable to a non-contractual obligation arising out of such a restriction shall be the law of the forum.

4. In cases where a restriction of competition does not affect trade between Member States within the meaning of Articles 81 or 82 of the EC Treaty, the law applicable to a non-contractual obligation arising out of such a restriction shall be the law of the country on whose market the restriction has or is likely to have effect."
