REPORT FROM THE COMMISSION TO THE COUNCIL

Grant of special allowances to compensate for particularly arduous working conditions in respect of the 1978 and 1979 financial years (Article 100 of the Staff Regulations)

COM(81) 297 final

REPORT TO THE COUNCIL

Under Article 100 of the Staff Regulations, special allowances may be granted for particularly arduous working conditions in the nuclear sector to officials and other staff paid from research and investment appropriations and assigned to duties requiring scientific and technical knowledge.

The special working conditions justifying the grant of an allowance and the number of points awarded per hour worked are specified in Article 3 of Council Regulation (Euratom) No 1799/72 of 18 August 1972:

I. safety of the individual

- (a) Wearing of particularly uncomfortable clothing for protection against fire, contamination, radiation or corrosive substances (10 to 50 points).
- (b) Partial protection (2 to 16 points).

II. Place of work

- (a) Confined (2 points)
- (b) Noisy (2 points)
- (c) Dangerous sites which necessitate the use of onerous protective appliances (2 to 5 points).

III. Nature of work

- (a) Handling or working with certain substances in conditions which make the work arduous (2 points).
- (b) Work with explosives as a pyrotechnist (5 points).

Article 2 of the abovementioned Regulation specifies that a point is equal to 0.032% of the basic salary of an official in Grade D4, first step, the allowance being adjusted by the weighting applicable to the official's remuneration.

This report covers the 1978 and 1979 financial years. In future, the report will be drawn up in April of each year and will relate to the previous financial year.

The annexed tables for the 1978 and the 1979 financial years give the following information:

Annexes I to IV

show the number of officials and other staff in each category in each JRC Establishment who received a special allowance in 1978 and 1979 together with the number of hours worked under the terms specified in Article 4 of the Regulation in question. The expenditure indicated is greater than that shown in the revenue and expenditure account, as the latter does not include the weighting.

Annex V

gives the same information for indirect actions.

Annex VI

indicates total expenditure on each allowance in 1978 and 1979.
