III. THE PROJECT

Procedure

- : The Commission will make DM 50 million available to the IKB (some 21.25 MioECU). This loan will be paid over three years in proportional instalments to approved subsidiary loans.
The subsidiary loans will be approved by Commission departments pursuant to the criteria and aims published by the Commission (O.J. n° C 178/2 of 27 July 1977 and O.J. n° C 82/8 of 29 March 1979).

The IKB will send annual reports to the Commission on the use made of the global loan and on reemployment of former ECSC workers in concerns financed by way of the global loan.

Total amount of investment : at least DM 100 million (+ 42.5 MioECU)

IV. THE REGION

Project location : Principally in Land North Rhine-Westphalia

Unemployment rate : 8.8% in Land North Rhine-Westphalia
(Federal Republic 6.9% in September 1982)

National aid status of project area : Regional aided areas : ECSC conversion areas

The ECSC industry has been and still is a major employer in the area.

V. CONFORMITY WITH ARTICLE 56 OF THE ECSC TREATY

ECSC redundancies in project area

- : The labour market situation especially in the Ruhr district continues to worsen and it is calculated that by end 1983 there will be at least 10,000 redundancies in the coal and steel industry. Further redundancies are anticipated in later years.

Jobs to be created by the project

- : Over 1,500 jobs, of which at least 1,000 will be suitable for former ECSC workers.

Training

- : Carried out, where applicable, by local organisations and by loan recipients.

The Commission considers that the application complies with Article 56 2a) of the ECSC Treaty.

VI. GLOBAL LOAN

Loan applied for

- : DM 50 million

Loan to be granted

- : The Commission has approved a loan of DM 50 million (about 21.25 MioECU) or equivalent to the above mentioned institution in accordance with Art. 56 application criteria (OJ C 82, 29 March 1979).

Interest rebate

- : 3 percentage points per year for five years on 20 MioECU

Job basis of interest rebate

- : 1,000 jobs suitable for former ECSC workers, to whom they will be offered in priority.
