Subject : Request for assent, pursuant to Article 56 2a) of the ECSC Treaty to the granting of a global loan to the Société Nationale de Crédit et d'Investissement (S.N.C.I.) ; Luxembourg.

I. FINANCIAL INTERMEDIARY

No. 400

Applicant : Société Nationale de Crédit et d'Investissement (S.N.C.I.)

Registered Office : Luxembourg.

Shareholders : The capital of the S.N.C.I. is composed solely of grants by the Luxembourg State, which is the sole shareholder of the S.N.C.I.

II. RECIPIENTS

: The S.N.C.I. will distribute the global loan to small and medium concerns, which create new activities and jobs.

Field of Activity of recipients : Industrial and service activities.

III. THE PROJECT

Procedure

: The Commission will make LFR 300 million available to the S.N.C.I. The Decision will be implemented by the conclusion of a framework agreement to be carried out in successive instalments. Subsidiary loans will be approved by the relevant departments of the Commission.

The Société Nationale de Crédit et d'Investissement will report to the Commission annually on the use made of borrowed funds. The S.N.C.I. will also report to the Commission annually on the number of jobs created, jobs filled and the number of redundant former ECSC workers re-employed.

Total amount of investment

: at least LFR 600 million

(± 13.02 MioECU)

Project location

: Grand Duchy of Luxembourg

Unemployment rate

: 1.6 %

National aid status of project area

: General aid rules with sectoral application

The ECSC industry has been and still is a major employer in the area.

V. CONFORMITY WITH ARTICLE 56 2a) OF THE ECSC TREATY

ECSC redundancies in project area : 5,012 (1977-1982)

- Jobs to be created by the project : Approximately 500 of which 325 will be former ECSC workers and on which the interest rebate will be based.
- Training : Provided by public centres of vocational training and/or by the concerns involved.

The Commission considers that the application complies with Article 56 2a) of the ECSC Treaty.

VI. GLOBAL LOAN

Loan applied for : LFR 300 million (± 6.51 MioECU)

- Loan to be granted : The Commission has approved a loan of LFR 300 million (about ± 6.51 MioECU) or equivalent to the above mentioned institution (1)
- Interest rebate : 5 percentage points per year for five years on 6.5 MioECU

Job basis of interest rebate : 325 jobs suitable for former ECSC workers.

VII. COUNCIL ASSENT

The Commission requests the Council to give its assent to the foregoing decision
