II. THE PROJECT

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Description

: The project consists of a new factory equipped to manufacture double-glazed patio doors and windows.

Market

: A production target of 92,800 double-glazed patio doors per annum is envisaged by 1987 which would replace imported units from the U.S.A. worth UK£ 7.6 million annually. The new plant's entire production will be purchased by other companies in the Group to be retailed directly to consumers.

Environment

: Environmental protection measures in accordance with current legislation

The sectoral and competition aspects of the project have been closely examined ; they do not militate against the granting of the loan applied for.

The project appears to be economically sound ; it will make a significant contribution to the redevelopment of the region which is suffering the effects of a decline in ECSC industries.

III. THE REGION

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<u>Project location</u>	: Babot Hall Industrial Estate Mangham Road, Park Gate, Rotherham, South Yorkshire, England
<u>Unemployment rate</u>	: (Yorkshire and Humberside) 19% Rotherham travel-to-work area (November, 1983)
<u>National aid status of project area</u>	: Development area

The ECSC industry has been an important source of employment in the area.

IV. CONFORMITY WITH ARTICLE 56 OF THE ECSC TREATY

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<u>ECSC redundancies in project area</u>	: 18046 steel and coal jobs lost since 1977 of which 10 058 were steel jobs lost since 1980.
<u>Jobs to be created by the project</u>	: 70 jobs suitable for ex-ECSC workers out of a total of 101 jobs.
<u>Training</u>	: Comprehensive off-the-job and on-the-job training will be provided for all new recruits in accordance with Industry Training Board requirements and good industrial practices.

The Commission considers that the application complies with Article 56 (2a) of the ECSC Treaty and that the new jobs to be created by the project are capable of absorbing redundant ECSC workers into productive employment.

V. CONVERSION LOAN
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- Loan applied for : UK£ 1.25 million
- Loan to be granted : The Commission has approved a loan of UK£1.25 million (about 2.13 MioECU) or equivalent to the above mentioned company (1).
- Interest rebate : 3 percentage points per year for five years on 1.4 MioECU.
- Job basis of interest rebate : 70 jobs suitable for former ECSC industry workers, to whom they will be offered in priority.

VI. COUNCIL ASSENT
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The Commission requests the Council to give its assent to the foregoing decision.
