COMMUNICATION FROM THE COMMISSION TO THE COUNCIL

on the renewal of the Cooperation Agreement between Atomic Energy of Canada Ltd. (AECL) and the European Atomic Energy Community on research in the field of nuclear waste management to be concluded by the Commission in pursuance of Article 101, third paragraph, of the Treaty establishing the European Atomic Energy Community

COMMUNICATION TO THE COUNCIL

on the renewal of the Cooperation Agreement between Atomic Energy of Canada Ltd (AECL) and the European Atomic Energy Community on research in the field of nuclear waste management to be concluded by the Commission in pursuance of Article 101, third paragraph, of the Treaty establishing the European Atomic Energy Community.

1. On 30 November 1980 the European Atomic Energy Community and Atomic Energy of Canada Ltd concluded a Cooperation Agreement in the field of nuclear waste management research, which is due to expire on 30 November 1985.
2. Taking into account the satisfactory cooperation which has been established during this Agreement, it has been considered mutually beneficial to continue this cooperation and, at the same time, to extend it to cover research aimed at characterizing high-activity waste.
3. The Management and Coordination Advisory Committee (CGC) and the former Advisory Committee on Programme Management (ACPM) competent in this area have delivered favourable opinions on the principle of extension of the Agreement and the expansion of its scope.
4. The Commission hereby informs the Council of its intention of concluding the appended supplementary Cooperation Agreement with Atomic Energy of Canada Ltd in accordance with the procedure provided for by Article 101, third paragraph, of the Treaty establishing the European Atomic Energy Community, procedure already applied for the conclusion of the original Agreement.

SUPPLEMENTARY COOPERATION AGREEMENT

between

ATOMIC ENERGY OF CANADA LIMITED/L'ENERGIE ATOMIQUE DU CANADA LIMITEE

and

THE EUROPEAN ATOMIC ENERGY COMMUNITY

in the field of nuclear waste management research

WHEREAS the Atomic Energy of Canada Limited/L'Energie Atomique du Canada Limitée (hereinafter referred to as "AECL") and the European Atomic Energy Community, acting through and represented by the Commission of the European Communities (hereinafter referred to as "EURATOM") entered into a Cooperation Agreement dated November 3, 1980 (hereinafter referred to as the "Original Agreement") under which the parties established a program of cooperation in particular fields of nuclear waste management research for a duration of five years; and

WHEREAS AECL and EURATOM recognize their mutual interest in renewing the Original Agreement for a new period of five years; and

WHEREAS AECL and EURATOM recognize their mutual interest in expanding the scope of the particular fields set out in the Original Agreement and wish to include therein the field of high-level waste characterization;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, AECL and EURATOM agree to modify the terms of the Original Agreement as follows :

1. The program of cooperation referred to in Article II of the Original Agreement shall be extended to include the characterization of high-level waste forms.
2. The duration of the Original Agreement referred to in its Article X shall be extended for a new period of five (5) years from the first day of the month next following the execution date of this Agreement.

3. The other terms of the Original Agreement shall remain unchanged.

This Agreement has been executed by the duly authorized officers of AECL and by the duly authorized representatives of EURATOM acting through the Commission of the European Communities this _____ day of _____ 1985.
