# PRELIMINARY DRAFT AMENDING BUDGET N° 4 TO THE GENERAL BUDGET 2009

STATEMENT OF EXPENDITURE BY SECTION Section III - Commission

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## Having regard to:

- the Treaty establishing the European Community, and in particular Article 272 thereof,
- the Treaty establishing the European Atomic Energy Community, and in particular Article 177 thereof,
- the Council Regulation (EC, Euratom) No 1605/2002 of 25 June 2002 on the Financial Regulation applicable to the general budget of the European Communities<sup>1</sup>, as last amended by Council Regulation (EC) No 1525/2007<sup>2</sup>, and in particular Article 37 thereof,

The European Commission hereby presents to the budgetary authority the Preliminary Draft Amending Budget No 4 to the 2009 budget.

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The changes to the statement of expenditure by section are forwarded separately via the SEI-BUD system. An English version of the changes to the statement of expenditure by section is attached for information as a budgetary annex.

### 1. Introduction

Preliminary Draft Amending Budget (PDAB) No 4 for the year 2009 concerns the translation into the Community budget of the political agreement reached on the financing of the European Economic Recovery Plan:

- For energy projects to aid economic recovery, commitment appropriations of EUR 2 billion and payment appropriations of EUR 76.2 million are proposed for budget 2009.
- For broadband internet infrastructure in rural areas and CAP Health Check "new challenges", commitment appropriations of EUR 0.6 billion are proposed for budget 2009.

In order to accommodate these increases, the Commission has submitted a proposal to revise the ceilings of the multi-annual financial framework for Headings 1a and 2.

### 2. ENERGY PROJECTS TO AID ECONOMIC RECOVERY

On 28 January 2009, the Commission presented its Communication "Investing today for tomorrow's Europe"<sup>3</sup>. This was accompanied by a proposal for a Regulation establishing a programme to aid economic recovery by granting Community financial assistance to projects in the field of energy<sup>4</sup>.

Following the political agreement reached on the financing of this initiative, it is proposed to create a new budget article 06 04 14 — Energy projects to aid economic recovery, and four new budget items, as follows:

### 3. BROADBAND INFRASTRUCTURE AND CAP "HEALTH CHECK"

The Commission has also proposed<sup>5</sup> to amend Regulation (EC) No 1698/2005 on support for rural development by the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development (EARDF) and Decision 2006/493/EC laying down the amount of Community support for rural development for the period from 1 January 2007 to 31 December 2013, its annual breakdown and the minimum amount to be concentrated in regions eligible under the Convergence Objective.

Accordingly, it is now proposed to increase budget item 05 04 05 01 Rural Development Programmes by EUR 0.6 billion in commitment appropriations for 2009.

The 2009 margin for heading 4 does not take into account the appropriations related to the Emergency Aid Reserve, or the mobilisation of the Flexibility Instrument.

For calculating the margin under the ceiling for heading 5, account is taken of the footnote (1) of the financial framework 2007-2013 for an amount of EUR 78 million for the staff contributions to the pension scheme.
