THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing a single Council and a single Commission of the European Communities,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 259/68 of 29 February 1968 laying down the Staff Regulations of Officials and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Communities (1), as last amended by Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 2577/75 (2), and in particular Article 94 of the Conditions of Employment,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas in Regulation (Euratom) No 11/65/Euratom (3), as last amended by Regulation (Euratom) No 1748/76 (4), the Council laid down the conditions governing remuneration and social security for establishment staff of the Joint Research Centre employed in the Netherlands,

Whereas the changes in salaries which were introduced on 1 July 1976 for the staff of the Reactor Centrum Nederland justify further amendment of Regulation No 11/65/Euratom for the establishment staff of the Joint Research Centre employed in the Netherlands,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The Annex to Regulation No 1/65/Euratom is replaced as follows with effect from 1 July 1976 :
