

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

3.3

On submission of its statement of estimates for the financial year 1984, the Court of Auditors stated that in the course of the budgetary procedure it would be proposing that appropriations be entered in the budget to cover the temporary allowances due to those Members of the Court whose terms of office expire on 17 October 1983 and are not being renewed.

Without wishing to influence the decision on appointment to be taken by the Council between now and 17 October next, after consulting the European Parliament, the Court of Auditors considers that the time has come to present the budgetary authority with a new estimate for Article 102 of Section V of the draft budget for the financial year 1984.

It is therefore proposed that the 46.700 ECU in appropriations under Article 102 should be increased by 168.300 ECU, thus making a total of 215.000 ECU.

This proposal, together with the automatic correction to be made in respect of Commission expenditure under Article 860 (Refunds to Greece), brings total appropriations for commitments under the 1984 preliminary draft budget to 28.620.014.496 ECU and total appropriations for payments to 25.528.588.866 ECU.

The VAT rate rises from 0,955820% to 0,955831%.

The rate of increase in non-compulsory expenditure rises from 34,218% to 34,221% in appropriations for commitments and from 13,808% to 13,811% in appropriations for payments.
