adjusting the weightings applied to the
remuneration and pensions of officials and
other servants of the European Communities

(submitted to the Council by the Commission)

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Article 65(2) of the Staff Regulations reads:

"In the event of a substantial change in the cost of living, the Council shall decide within two months what adjustments should be made to the weightings and, if appropriate, to apply them retrospectively.

The Statistical Office of the European Communities, in agreement with the statistical offices of the Member States and the OECD, has prepared joint indexes showing changes in the cost of living in the second half of 1976 in Brussels and in the various countries where staff are employed.

On 31 December 1976 (June 1976 = 100) the figures for the various countries were as follows:

Canada ²	102.7

The Commission feels that these considerable increases warrant salary adjustments with effect from 1 January 1977.

The Commission therefore proposes that the weightings applicable to the remuneration of officials in their various countries of employment should be adjusted as indicated in the attached proposal for a regulation.

adjusting the weightings applied to the remuneration and pensions of officials and other servants of the European Communities

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing a Single Council and a Single Commission of the European Communities,

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Communities laid down by Council Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 259/68¹, as last amended by Regulation (ECSC, EEC, Euratom) No 3177/76², and in particular Articles 64, 65(2) and 82 of the Staff Regulations and the first paragraph of Article 20 and Article 64 of the Conditions of Employment,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas, by reason of the substantial rise in the cost of living which took place during the second half of 1976 in Belgium and in the other countries where officials and other servants of the European Communities are employed, the weightings applied to the remuneration and pensions of officials and other servants should be adjusted with effect from 1 January 1977,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

1. With effect from 1 January 1977 the weightings applicable to the remuneration of officials employed in the countries listed below shall be as follows:

Denmark	129.8
Germany	83.3
France	126.4
Ireland	135.0
Italy	132.1
Luxembourg	104.5
Netherlands	96.9
United Kingdom	135.9
Canada	130.5
Japan	151.4
Switzerland	83.1
USA	132.2

2. With effect from 1 January 1977 the weighting applicable to pensions in accordance with the second subparagraph of Article 82(1) of the Staff Regulations shall be as shown below for the Community country in which the person entitled to the pension declares his home to be:

Belgium	104.5
Denmark	129.8
Germany	83.3
France	126.4
Ireland	135.0
Italy	132.1
Luxembourg	104.5
Netherlands	96.9
United Kingdom	135.9

If a person entitled to a pension declares his home to be in a country other than those listed above, the weighting applicable to the pension shall be that for Belgium.

Article 2

Article 5(2)(a) and (b) of Regulation (ECSC, EEC, Euratom) No 3177/76 is repealed with effect from 1 January 1977.

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
