  A total suspension is proposed for those products for which Community production does not exist or is minimal.

  A partial suspension is proposed in cases where the Community production covers only a part of the requirements. The rate of the partially suspended duty depends on the extent of the possible Community supply to the Community users. It has also been looked for the right balance between the interests of the suppliers, users and the consumers in the Community.

  Furthermore the need to protect employment has been taken into consideration.
- 3. For a number of items for which the Member States also requested duty suspensions the Commission does not propose a tariff measure because the necessary conditions are not fulfilled. This concerns the following items:

### EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

... The subject of the following draft regulation is the temporary suspension of duties in the Common Customs Tariff for a number of agricultural items, as requested by the Member States.

2. It seems appropriate to the Commission that a duty suspension is justified for the goods listed in the annex to this regulation.

The Commission proposes a total suspension for those products for which Community production does not exist or is minimal. A partial suspension is proposed in cases where the Community production covers only a part of the requirements. The rate of the partially suspended duty depends on the extent of the possible Community supply to the Community users. The Commission is also looking for the right balance between the interests of the suppliers, users and the consumers in the Community.

It also takes into account the need to protect employment.

- 3. The proposed measures are confined to a fixed period because of the difficulties of estimating the evolution of the basic factors.
- 4. For a number of items for which the Member States also requested duty suspensions the Commission does not propose a tariff measure because the necessary conditions are not fulfilled. This concerns the following items :

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES.

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 28 thereof,

Having regard to the draft Regulation submitted by the Commission,

Whereas production in the Community of the products specified in this Regulation is currently inadequate or non-existent, and whereas producers thus cannot meet the needs of user industries in the Community;

Whereas in certain cases it is in the interest of the Community to suspend the autonomous Common Customs Tariff duties only partially particularly since the goods in question are produced in the Community, and in the other cases to suspend them totally;

Whereas, in view of the difficulty of assessing accurately short-term trends in the economic situation in the relevant sectors, suspension measures should be taken only for temporary periods by fixing their

period of validity by reference to the interests of Community production,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

#### Article 1

The autonomous Common Customs Tariff duties for the products listed in the tables annexed to this Regulation shall be suspended at the level indicated against each of them.

These suspensions shall be applicable,:

- from 1 July to 31 December 1980 for the products listed in Table I.
- from 1 July 1980 to 30 June 1981 for the products listed in Table II,

### : Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 July 1980

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
