EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Article 9 and Annex II of Regulation (EEC) No 2915/79 laid down the free-at-frontier values for cheese applicable to imports into the Community.

Australia and New Zealand have had difficulty in exporting the quota amounts allocated to them because Community market prices are too low in comparison with the values that have to be respected for Australian and New Zealand Cheddar.

In view of this the Council on 26 September 1983 adopted Regulation (EEC) No 2692/83 derogating from this provision on respect of the free-at-frontier values.

As these values are still too high in comparison with Community market prices to allow Cheddar to be imported the derogation must be extended for a further three-month period.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 804/68 of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in milk and milk products (1), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1600/83 (2), and in particular Article 14(6) thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas Article 9 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2915/79 of 18 December 1979 determining the groups of products and the special provisions for calculating levies on milk and milk products and amending Regulation (EEC) No 950/68 on the Common Customs Tariff (3), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1206/83 (4), lays down provisions governing the entry into the Community of cheeses as listed in Annex II (e) and (f) of that Regulation consigned from third countries;

Whereas the state of the Community market in Cheddar cheese which led to the adoption of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2692/83 of 26 September 1983 derogating from the application of certain provisions relating to the adjustment of free-at-frontier values of certain cheeses (5) still does not allow importation into the Community at the free-at-frontier values laid

down in Annex II (e) and (f) of Regulation (EEC) No 2915/79 of cheese of the types in question originating in Australia and in New Zealand; whereas this derogation should therefore be extended for three months,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

In Article 1 of Regulation (EEC) No 2692/83 the date of 31 December 1983 is replaced by 31 March 1984.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 January 1984.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
