EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Regulation (EEC) N° 1760/78 provides for the common measure to improve infrastructure in certain rural areas to be implemented over a period of five years from the entry into force of the Regulation.

Drawing up and approving the outline programmes took in France and in Italy 12 and 22 months respectively

On the basis of experience gained from applying the first specific programmes, the provision concerning the time allowed for implementing the common measure has been made more flexible in the case of specific programmes adopted from 1981 onwards in that the time allowed is counted from the date on which the programme is approved.

Five years should be allowed for the implementation of these programmes.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,  
and in particular Article 43 therof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Having regard to the opinion of the European Parliament (2),

Whereas a period of five years was considered necessary for carrying out the  
work under the programmes,

Whereas drawing up the outline programmes took longer than expected and for  
that reason the programmes did not begin to be implemented in France and in  
Italy until 12 and 22 months respectively after the entry into force of  
Regulation (EEC) N° 1760/78 ;

Whereas a period of five years should be allowed for implementing the  
programmes,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

Article 11 § 1 shall be replaced by the following :

"1. The period envisaged for implementing the common measure shall be five years from the date of approval of the last outline programme as referred to in Article 2."

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.
