

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Regulation (EEC) No 1119/78 establishes a system of aid for peas and field beans for use in animal feed, whereby aid is granted to feedingstuffs manufacturers who have undertaken to pay producers a price not lower than the minimum price.

On account of the currency situation, and in the absence of monetary compensatory amounts in this sector, producers in some Member States have an advantage over those in other Member States (the United Kingdom in particular), to the extent that feedingstuffs manufacturers have an interest in obtaining supplies in Member States where the minimum price, converted into national currency, is lowest.

The object of this proposed Regulation is to allow the Council to establish a system of monetary adjustment to overcome the distortions in the Community market which result from this currency situation.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Articles 42 and 43 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Having regard to the opinion of the European Parliament (1),

Having regard to the opinion of the Economic and Social Committee<sup>(2)</sup>,

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 1119/78 (3), as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1459/80 (4), introduced an aid system for peas and field beans harvested within the Community and employed as animal feed; whereas such aid is to be granted only to animal feed manufacturers who have undertaken to pay producers a price not less than the minimum price;

Whereas, on account of the monetary situation, and in the absence of monetary compensatory amounts in this sector, producers in some Member States have an unjustified advantage over producers in other Member States to the extent to which animal feed manufacturers have an interest in obtaining supplies in Member States where the minimum price converted into national currency is lowest; whereas the result is a distortion of the Community market for the said products;

Whereas it accordingly appears necessary to make provision for a system of monetary adjustment for the said peas and field beans.

Article 1

The following Article 2a is hereby inserted into Regulation (EEC) No 1119/78:

"Article 2a"

The Council, acting by qualified/ majority on a proposal by the Commission, may introduce a system of monetary adjustment for peas and field beans used in the feeding of animals."

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

## 5.2 METHOD OF CALCULATION

On the basis of the minimum price for the 1981/82 marketing year (244,70 ECU/t), an aid figure of 90 ECU/t (beginning of October 1981) and gaps between the central rates of the ECU (12.10.1981), the effect of the adjustment system may be estimated at supplementary expenditure of 320 000 ECU.
