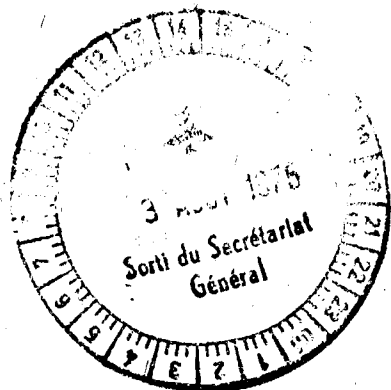

Professor Triffin's work for the Directorate-General for Economic and Financial Affairs as special adviser in 1975 took the following forms:

Professor Triffin published a number of widely-read studies on economic and monetary matters. Most of these were made available to the Commission before publication.

At a more technical level he continued to supply commentaries and documents on the development of international monetary reserves, the US balance of payments and payments relations between major countries or major groups of countries. Finally, he discussed the development of the international monetary situation with Commission officials either in Brussels or at symposia and conference held elsewhere.

(b) Justification for 1977

Analysis of international monetary developments, opinions on problems associated with the reform of the international monetary system and European monetary union.
