EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The aim of this Regulation is to fix for 1983 the guide prices for the products listed in Annex I (A) and (D) to Regulation (EEC) No 3796/81 on the common organization of the market in fishery products. Article 10 of the Regulation provides that a guide price is to be fixed for each of these products for each fishing year on the basis of the average of prices recorded for a significant proportion of Community output and a product with given commercial characteristics on representative wholesale markets or in representative ports during the three fishing years immediately preceding the year for which the price is fixed. In fixing the price, account is also to be taken of production and demand prospects and of other criteria relating to the stabilization of market prices, the support of producers' income and consumers' interests.

The starting point of the procedure for fixing prices for 1983 was a comparison of the average of prices referred to above recorded during the period from 1980 to 1982 (1982: 6 months) with that for the period from 1979 to 1981, the latter having been used to fix the guide price for 1982.

Account is taken in the guide prices proposed for 1983 of the overall improvement of the fisheries market, market weaknesses observed in 1981 having continued only for some species. In view of that trand account was taken of the impact of guide prices for 1983 on the level of withdrawal prices and the desired relationship between the latter and the prices recorded on Community markets.

It is proposed therefore:

- to prolong in 1983, for herring and Atlantic sardines, the guide prices valid for 1982;
- to increase the guide price from, depending on the species, 2 % to 6 % for the other products.

fixing the guide prices for the fishery products listed in Annex I (A) and (D) of Regulation (EEC) No 3796/81 for the 1983 fishing year

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Regulation (EEC) No 3796/81 of 29 December 1981 on the common organization of the market in fishery products 1 and in particular Article 10(3) thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas Article 10(1) and (2) of Regulation (EEC) No 3796/81 provides that a guide price shall be fixed for each of the products listed in Annex I (A) and (D) to that Regulation at a level which will help to stabilize market price and avoid the formation of surpluses in the Community;

Whereas that level must also help support producers' income and at the same time take account of consumers' interest;

Whereas the guide price shall be based on the average of prices as defined in Article 10(2) of the Regulation and on an assessment of production and demand prospects;

Whereas the application of the criteria laid down in Article 10 of Regulation (EEC) No 3796/81 and referred to above involves for the 1983 fishing year an increase for certain products and the stabilization of prices for others compared with prices applicable during the current fishing year; whereas in:view of the seasonal variations in the characteristics of plaice, the guide price should be increased from 1 May 1983; whereas, in the absence of certain information concerning price trends for each fishery product with given commercial characteristics, consideration should be given to the relationship between the average weighted market prices recorded when the guide prices were fixed for the previous fishing year for these products, and the average weighted market prices now current,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The guide prices for the 1983 fishing year for the products listed in Annex I (A) and (D) to Regulation (EEC) No 3796/81 and the products to which they relate are fixed in the Annex hereto.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter in force on 1 January 1983.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

COOLINTS: (1) Since it is a matter of fixing prices, the impact on expenditure will be indirect. The expenditure in question is heavily dependent on developments in the market and the quantities landed. In 1982 appropriations amounted to 31.75 million ECU. Subject to cértain doubts concerning the budget implications of the entry into force of the new arrangements for the organisation of markets, the 1983 appropriations of 37.05 million ECU provided for in Chapter 30 of the proposed budget can be considered adequate.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Regulation (EEC) No 3796/81 on the common organization of the market in fishery products provides that a reference price is to be fixed for each of the products listed in Annex II to that Regulation based on the average of prices recorded for a significant proportion of Community output and a product with given commercial characteristics on representative wholesale markets or in representative ports during the three fishing years immediately preceding the year for which the price is fixed.

An examination of price trends for the products in question indicates that the guide prices should be increased for certain products and maintained for others, at their current level, for the 1983 fishing year.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 3796/81 of 29 December 1981 on the common organization of the market in fishery products and in particular Article 15(5) thereof.

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas Article 15(1) of Regulation (EEC) No 3796/81 provides that a guide price shall be fixed annually for each of the products or groups of products listed in Annex II to that Regulation;

Whereas according to the data available at present concerning prices for the products in question and the criteria laid down in Article 10 of that Regulation the prices should be increased for certain products and maintained for others for the 1983 fishing year,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The guide prices for the 1983 fishing year for the products listed in Annex II to Regulation (EEC) No 3796/81 and the products to which they relate are fixed in the Annex hereto.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 January 1983.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Mamber States.

Regulation (EEC) No 3796/81 on the common organization of the market in fishery products provides that a Community producer price is to be fixed for tuna intended for the canning industry based on the average of prices recorded for a significant proportion of Community output and a product with given commercial characteristics on representative wholesale markets or in representative ports during the three fishing years immediately preceding the year for the which the price is fixed.

It is proposed on the basis of the data available that the Community producer price for the 1983 fishing year be maintained.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES.

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 3796/81 of 29 December 1981 on the common organization of the market in fishery products, 1 and in particular Article 17(5) thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas Article 17(4) of Regulation (EEC) No 3796/81 provides that a Community producer price shall be fixed for tuna intended for the canning industry;

Whereas, on the basis of the criteria laid down in Article 17(4) of the above Regulation, the price for the 1983 fishing year should be maintained,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The Community producer price for the 1983 fishing year for tuna for the canning industry and the product to which it relates are hereby fixed as follows:
